Municipal Action for Immigrant Integration (MAII) is a new project of the National League of Cities. The primary goal of MAII is to

promote civic engagement and naturalization among immigrant communities in cities throughout the United States.

In addition, the project will establish a **knowledge-sharing network** across different cities and organizations. MAII aims to be a resource for municipal officials and community-based organizations who seek assistance in **addressing immigrant integration challenges** in their communities.


CITYzenship
COMMUNITY FORUM

In a pilot program, MAII staff will provide one-year, targeted training and technical assistance to help cities conduct **CITYzenship Community Forum** sessions to as many as six cities over an initial three-year project period. The CITYzenship Community Forum helps cities **convene a diverse group** (city officials, representatives from community-based organizations, and service providers) and helps them **develop a community action plan** for managing immigrant integration challenges specific to their communities.

NATURALIZATION CAMPAIGN

The **NewCITYzen Naturalization Campaign** will highlight the many benefits of naturalization—voting rights and beyond. After completing the CITYzenship Community Forum, cities will use the **Campaign Toolkit to launch naturalization campaigns in their communities**. Cities not part of the pilot program may also use the Campaign Toolkit to implement Naturalization Campaigns.
