DEP and CDC publishes list of chemicals of high concern from existing gov,t lists by 1/ 1/2010

DEP convenes stakeholders to advise on protocol for designation of *priority chemicals*

From the list of chemicals of high concern, DEP designates at least 2 *priority chemicals* by 1/1/2011 through routine technical rulemaking by the Board of Env Protection

DEP designates a *priority chemical*, triggers mandatory disclosure of use info by manufacturers of children's products containing *priority chemical*; at discretion of DEP

DEP collects, compiles and reviews data from manufacturers and relevant data from other sources

Does data suggest need for safer alternatives?

DEP may require alternatives assessment from manufacturers of children's products that contain the *priority chemical*

DEP collects and reviews information on availability and safety of alternatives

BEP solicits, reviews and responds in writing to comments from interested parties

BEP provisionally adopts rule

Legislature approves final rule adoption
